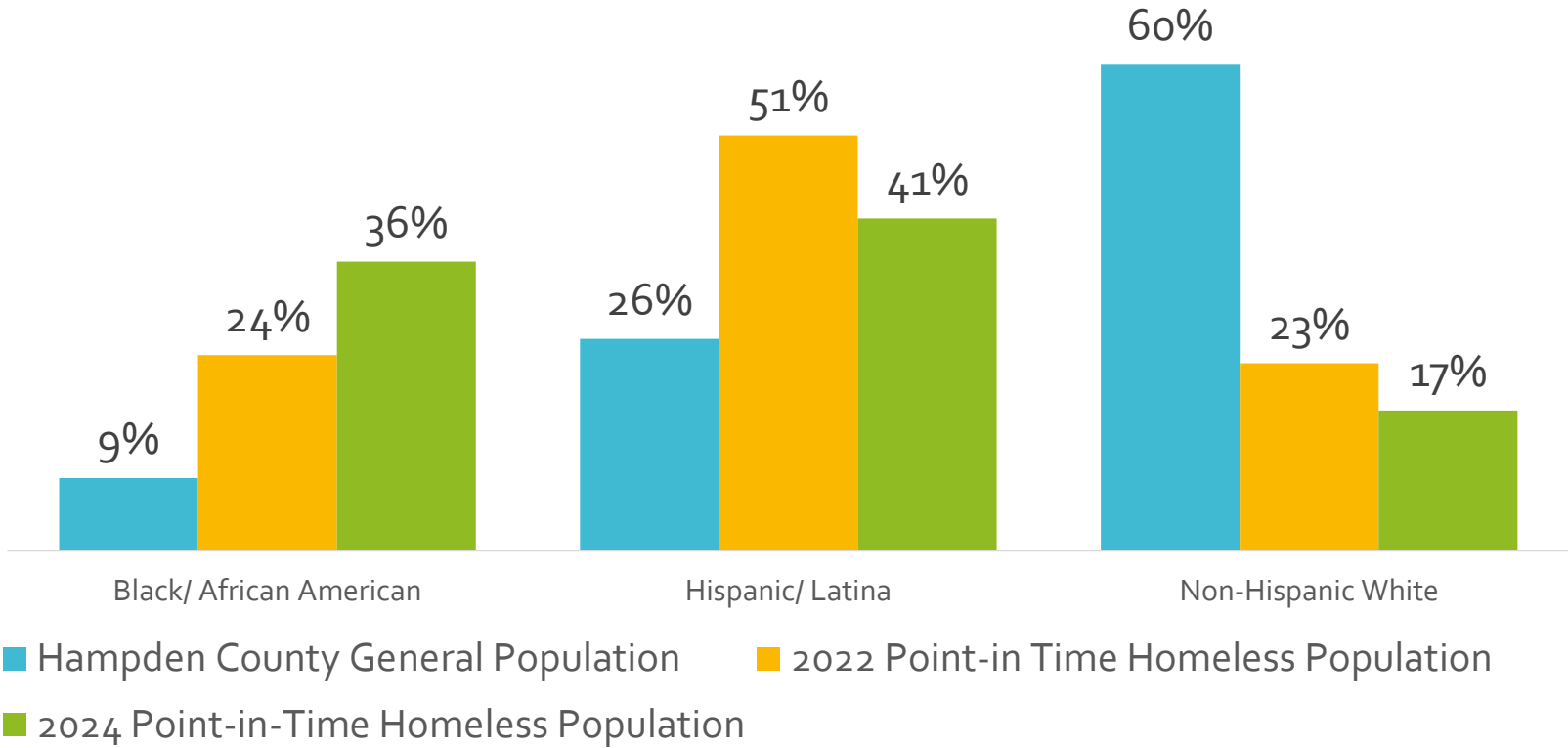


# Comparing the Counts 2020-2024



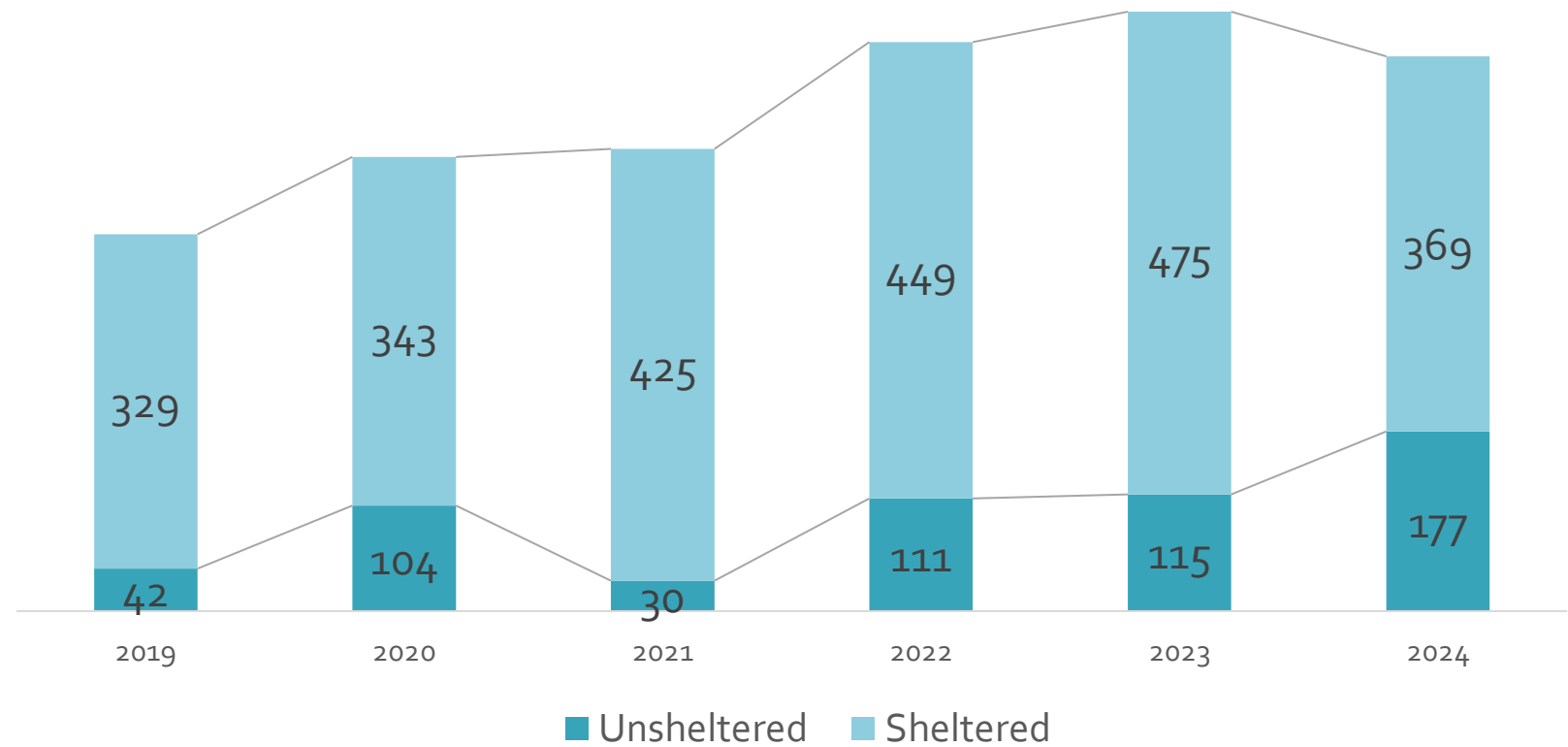
# Race and Ethnicity – Totals

Homelessness disproportionately impacts people of color

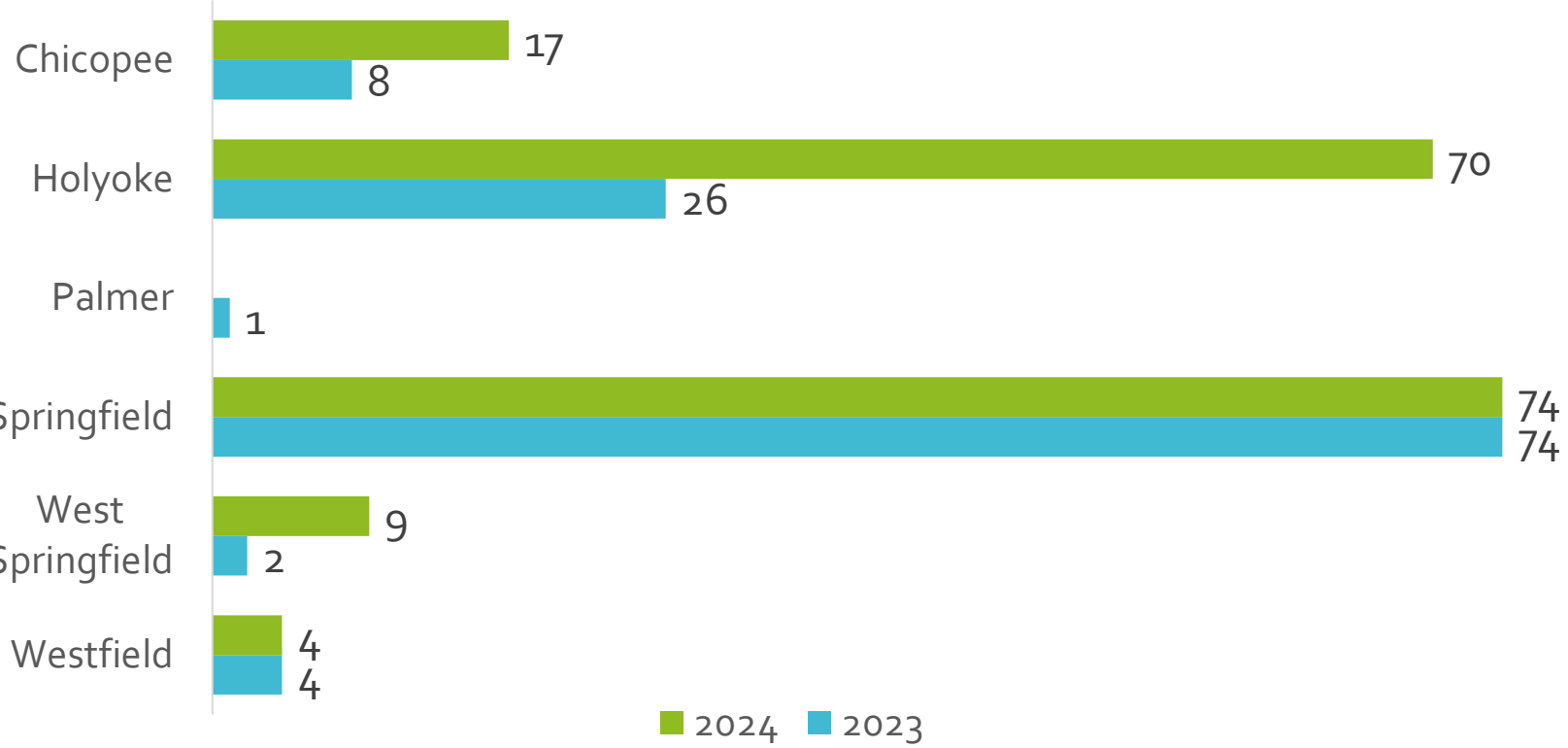


# Individuals: Sheltered and Unsheltered

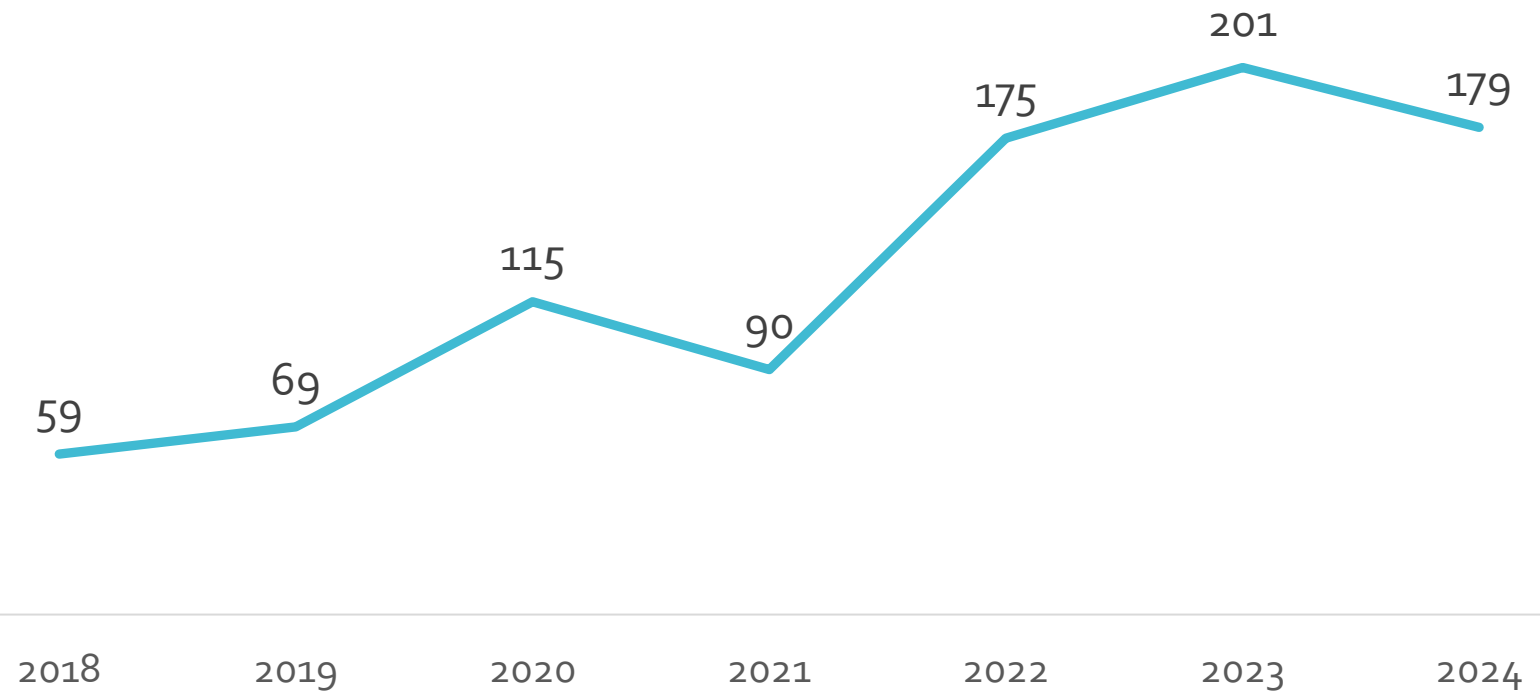
The number of shelter beds for individuals decreased from 2023 to 2024. The number of unsheltered homeless people increased.



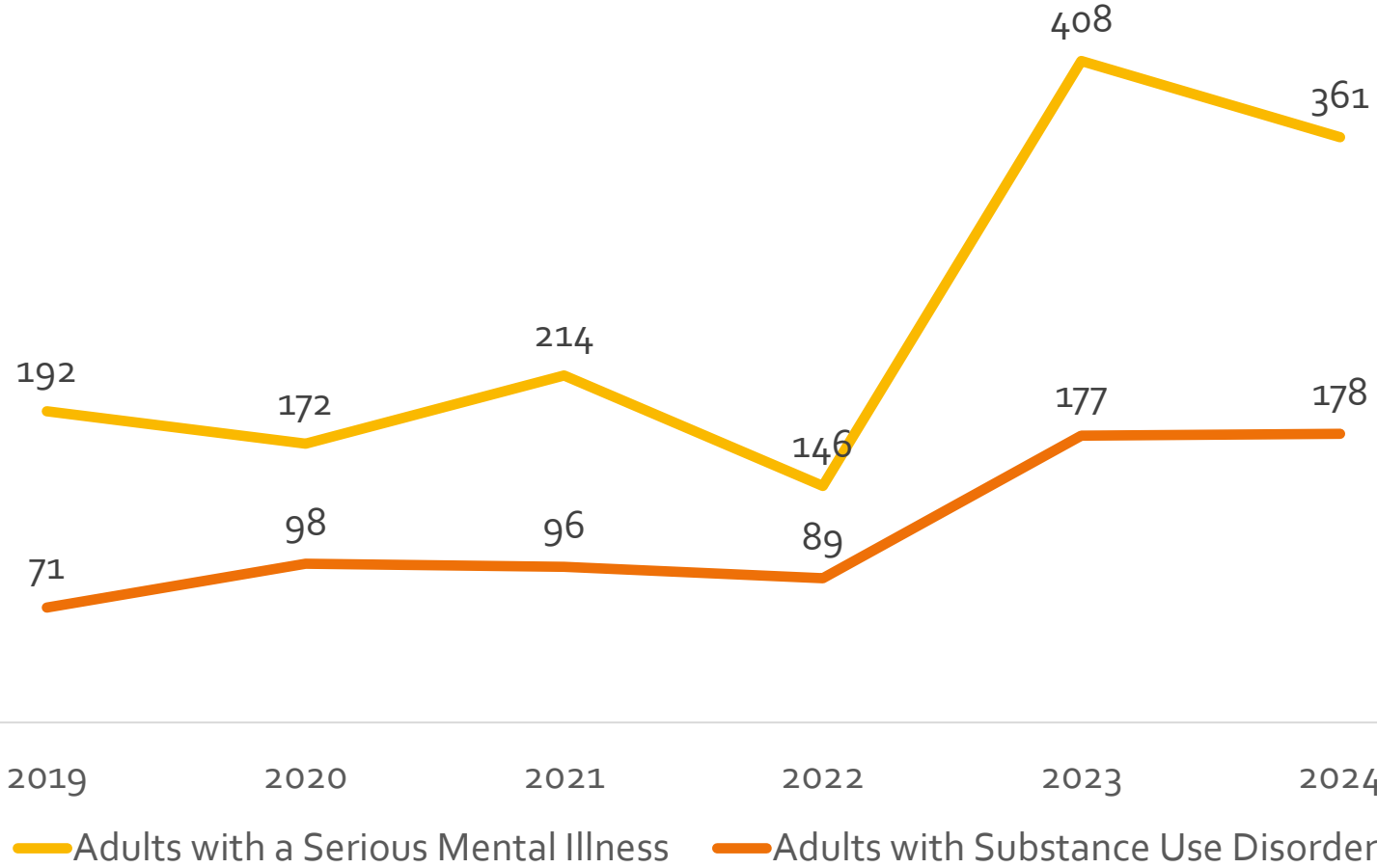
# Location of Unsheltered Homelessness



# Chronically Homeless Individuals



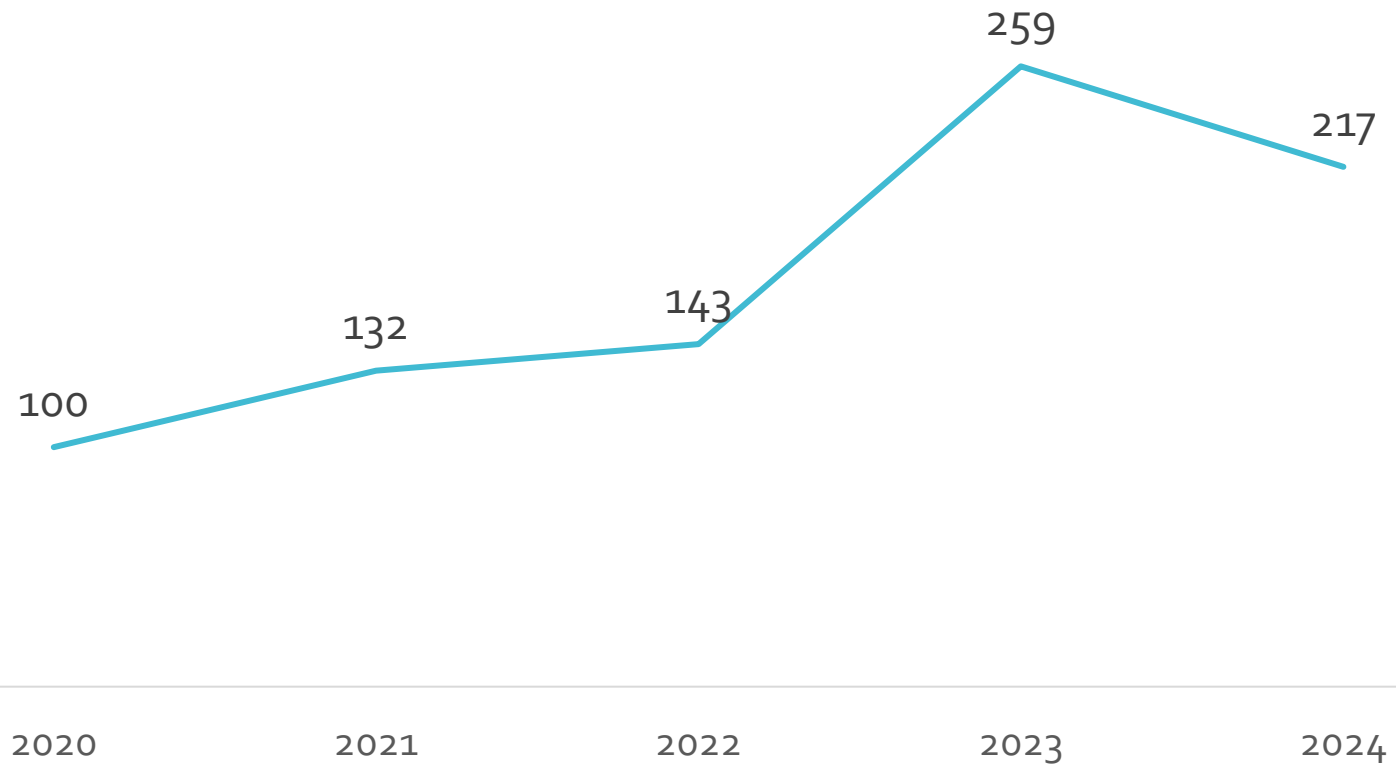
# Homeless Sub Populations





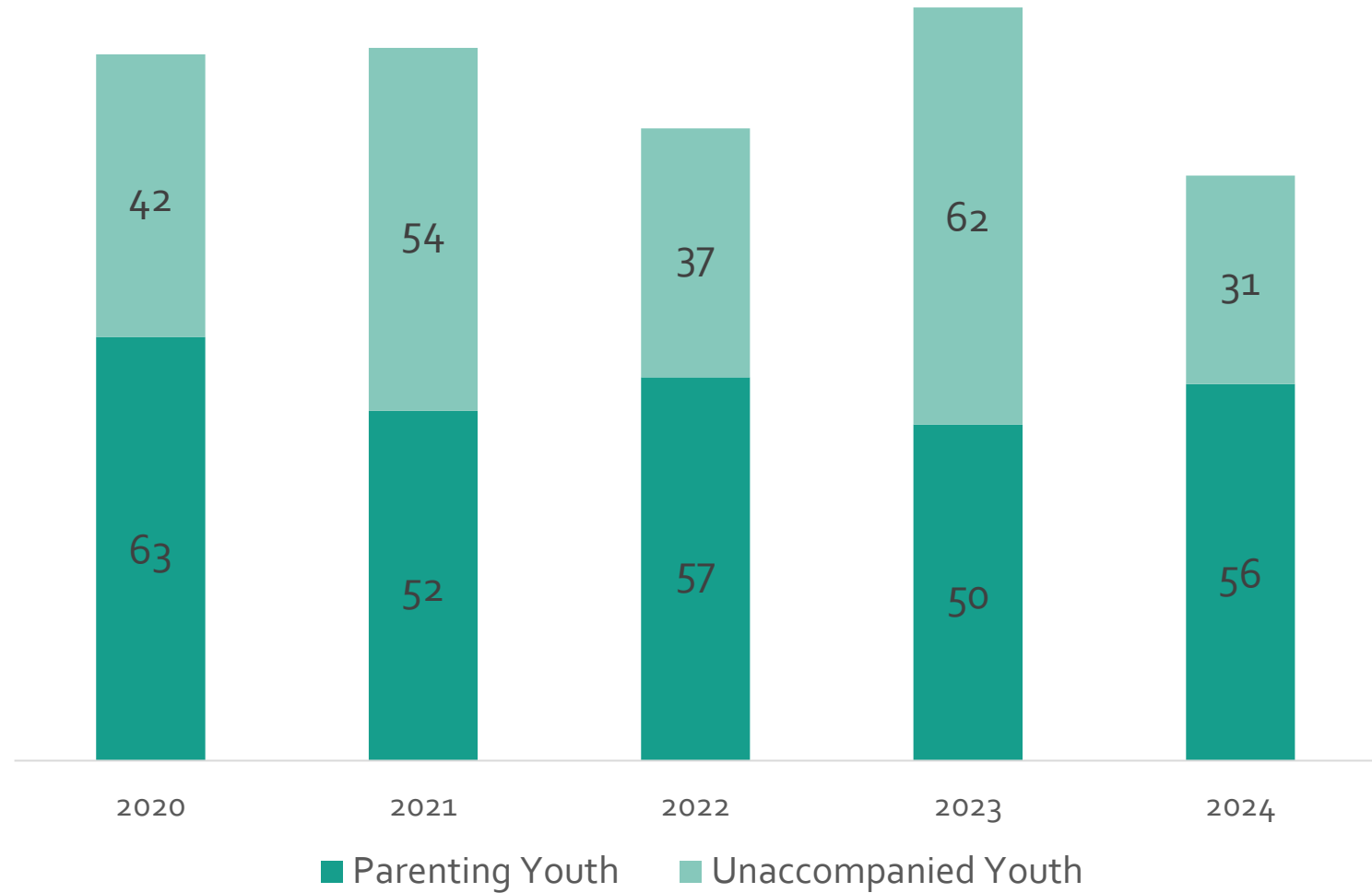
# Fleeing Domestic Violence
