Chapter 10.20

Wetland Protection Regulations

10.20.030 Jurisdiction.

Except as permitted by the conservation commission or as provided in this ordinance, no person shall remove, fill, dredge, alter, or build upon or within any of the following resource areas: On or within one hundred (100) feet of any bank, beach, or flat; on or within 100 feet of any fresh water wetland, marsh, meadow, bog, or swamp; upon or within one hundred (100) feet of any lake, pond, river, stream whether intermittent or permanent natural or man-made; upon any land subject to flooding or inundation by ground water or surface water or storm flowage and upon or within one hundred (100) feet of any seasonal or temporary wetland including certified or uncertified but known verbal pools. Any activity proposed or undertaken outside any area specified above shall be subject to regulation under this ordinance if, in the judgment of the conservation commission or its agent, said activity may result or has resulted in the removing, filling, altering, or building upon any area specified above.
